About Chris

L/Cpl Chris Cosgrove III was 23 years old when he was killed on October 1, 2006 by a suicide bomber at an entry control check point in Fallujah, Iraq. Chris was less than one week away from leaving Fallujah to start his journey home, after serving a 7 month tour of duty.

Chris graduated in 2001 from Whippany Park High School and from Monmouth University in 2005 where he majored in History. He planned to pursue a career in Law Enforcement upon his return home. He was engaged to be married in August, 2007.

He was a reservist with G Company of the 2nd Battalion, 25th Marines at Picatinny Arsenal. That unit had participated in Operation Iraqi Freedom in 2003 and was not scheduled to return. But Charlie Company, 1st Battalion, 25th Marines, 4th Marine Division from Plainville, Connecticut, which was being deployed to Iraq, needed additional Marines to go with their unit, so Chris volunteered to join them because that's just the kind of guy he was.

Giving back was important to Chris. He joined the United States Marine Corps Reserves in May 2004 because he wanted to do his part to protect our country. Becoming a Marine had always been a dream of his. He also became a member of the Marine Corps League Slatery Detachment #206 in Whippany, where he participated in the Marines Helping Marines program. Chris was able to visit wounded Marines and other military at Bethesda Naval Hospital in Virginia. Chris was honored to be a member of the Marine Corps League and to have had the opportunity to visit with the many special men and women who put their life on the line.

Few people realize, without first hand experience, the needs of those injured in the line of duty and their families.. That is why Legacy of a Hero was established – to continue the work that Chris himself would have continued to love being a part of. It is the goal of Legacy Of A Hero to provide assistance to our true heroes (military, police, firefighters, EMT's), who may be in need of financial, emotional or physical assistance.
